Even when the economic security fails

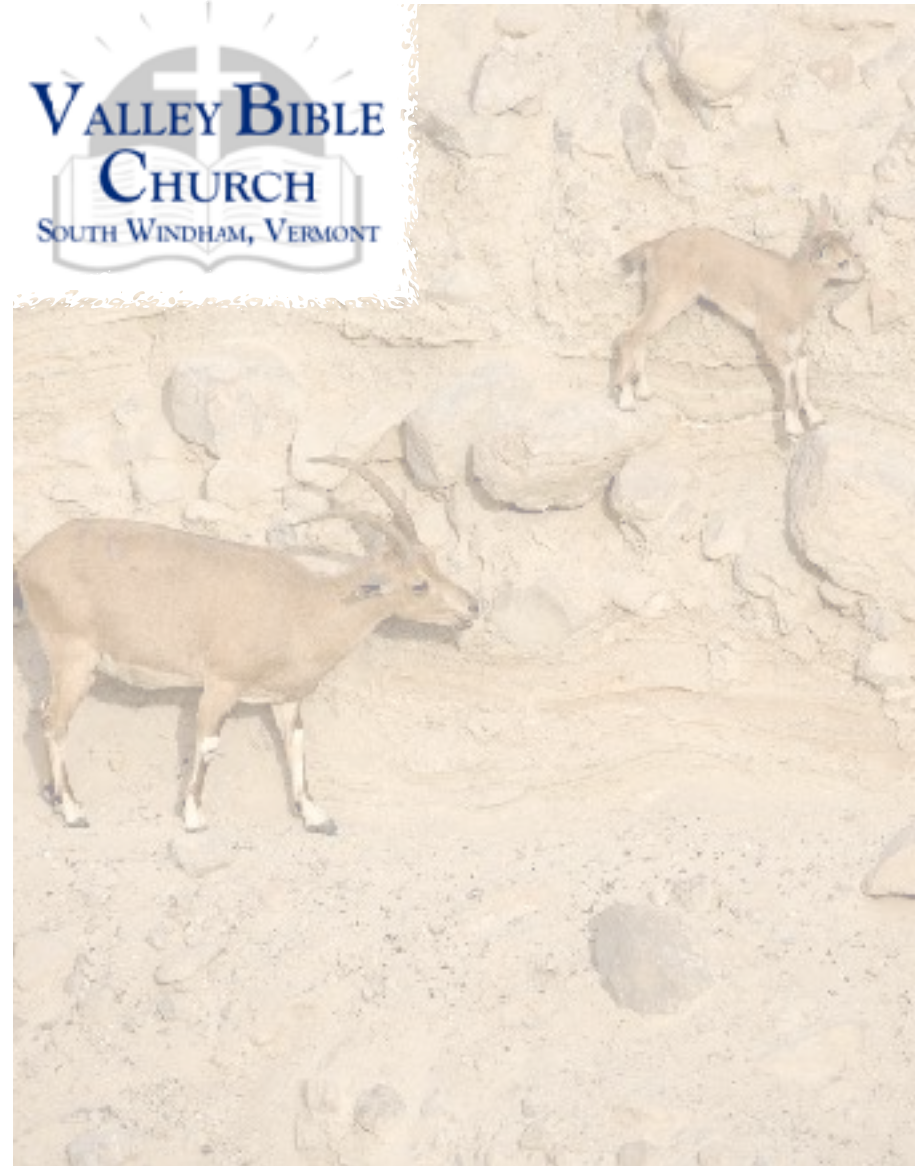
Because God himself is the source of our supply (cf. Joel 2:23-29)
