We do not lose heart!

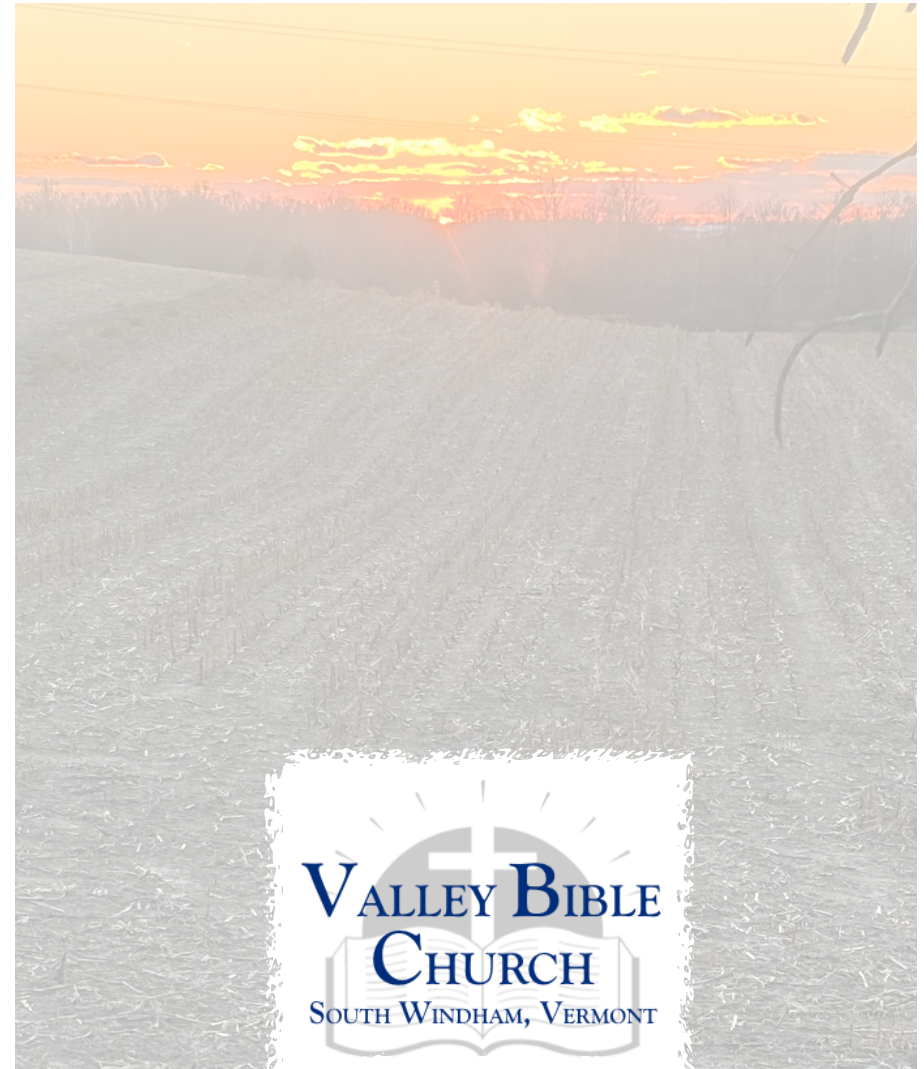
The Struggle is Real
